Dear Referee,

As this season has concluded we are sure that some referee's who are currently a Level 3 official will be considering their personal development and looking to progress to a Level 4 official. To avoid any disappointment and officials investing time in the application form to fall short of the entrance criteria we have put together this guide to help support Level 3 candidates in making their decisions.

To apply for the Level 4 which is England Basketball's highest National Award, and be considered a candidate, you are expected to have met all of the following,

- Have held the Level 3 award for at least 1 year
- Has good spoken and written English
- Have attended conference in September 2010
- Passed the rules test at the start of 2010-2011 season
- Passed the fitness test at the start of the 2010-2011 season
- Have refereed a number of Division 1 and 2 men's games and Div 1 women's games without difficulties
- Be in good physical shape and of a good physical profile
- Send a completed application for to Simon Unsworth by Monday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2010
